



As you're aware, the Cal/OSHA Standard Board approved revisions to the COVID-19 Prevention Emergency Temporary Standards (ETS) based on the latest recommendations from the California Department of Public Health. The revised ETS are effective on January 14, 2022 and expiring 90 days later on April 22, 2022. Failure to comply with the new ETS may result in an OSHA citation and penalty in accordance with the Division's penalty structure.
